GRANT APPLICATION

From 1917 to 1980 the women of the Ebell of Los Angeles were the overseers of a Rest Cottage that "provide[d] a place of rest for women who, because of their physical condition, need[ed] rest and quiet for a period of time to enable them to resume their former occupation." (Rest Cottage Association bylaws) When the last of two Rest Cottages was sold in 1980, the proceeds were placed in an already established Rest Cottage Association endowment that totaled approximately \$4 million in 2007, the yearly interest of which is now given to organizations that fund charitable projects which help women in need today. Recently, the Rest Cottage Association - *"Ebell Women Helping Women"* - has given approximately \$180,000 yearly to organizations in and around Los Angeles that continue to help women in need.
